- ☐ Vinyl Eraser
- ☐ Soft Vine Charcoal
- ☐ Soft, Medium, and Hard Charcoal Pencils (General's peel and sketch pencils recommended)
 - ☐ Sandpaper for Sharpening Charcoal if not included in kit
- ☐ X-acto Knife
- ☐ 18" Ruler
- ☐ Blending Stick or Paper Towels
- ☐ 14 x 17 Strathmore Drawing Pad (larger is fine)
